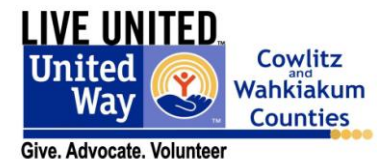
CWLA is a pro bono (for the public good) program. Local attorneys volunteer advice and services for civil legal matters (not criminal matters or drivers license issues).

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

First, call CLEAR. The phone numbers are listed on this brochure. The hours of operation for CLEAR are 9:15am to 12:15pm, Monday through Friday. You may experience busy phone lines. Keep trying and you will get through. Based on the information you provide, you may be given some immediate advice over the phone. Or, CLEAR may refer your case to a local Northwest Justice Project attorney or CWLA for follow-up. We will contact you and connect you with our services:

WHAT IS AN ADVICE CLINIC?

An advice clinic is a free, 30 minute consultation with a volunteer attorney.

It takes place either at the office of a local attorney who has donated their time to see clients, or at the CWLA office.

Bring your legal documents and the legal forms you have filled out. The attorney will need the facts of your case and will probably want to review your documents. The attorney will advise you on how to proceed with your case.

Prepare specific questions about the legal issues, documents or how to fill out your forms. Bring your questions to the advice clinic.

Our volunteer attorneys will provide advice and coaching on how to proceed with your case on your own. They will not prepare documents or represent you in court. It is best to take careful notes and complete the paperwork and procedures that the attorney suggests.

Clients can schedule as many advice clinics as they need to complete their case.
